G.S.R. 18.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Data Processing Division and Survey Design and Research Division, National Sample Survey Organisation (Class I and Class II posts) Recruitment Rules, 1973, in so far as they relate to the post of Deputy Director Administration (Data Processing) except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Deputy Director (Administration) in the Data Processing Division and Survey Design and Research Division of National Sample Survey Organisation, Department of Statistics, Ministry of Planning, namely:

1. Short title and commencement :—(1) These rules may be called the Data Processing Division and Survey Design and Research Division, National Sample Survey Organisation Deputy Director (Administration) Recruitment Rules, 1998.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay :—The number of the posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification, etc.: The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and

other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification :—No person—

(1) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(2) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Central Government may satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage; and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax :—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

6. Savings :—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Officers under the Central Government:—

- I. (a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis; or
- (ii) With 5 years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 8000-13500 or equivalent; or
- (iii) With 8 years combined regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 6500-10500 or equivalent; and
- (b) Having 5 years' experience in Administration, Accounts and Establishment work.

II. The Departmental Administrative Officer with 5 years' regular service in the grade of Administrative Officer with 8 years' combined regular service in the Grade of Administrative Officer and Accounts-cum-Administrative Officer shall also be considered along with deputationists and in case he is selected for appointment to the post the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years. The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications).
