G.S.R. 1175.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Central Statistical Organisation (Recruitment to Class II posts in the Industrial Statistics Wing) Rules, 1960, the President hereby makes the following rules, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(i) These rules may be called the Central Statistical Organisation (Recruitment to Class II posts in the Industrial Statistics Wing) Rules, 1968.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.

3. Number, classification and scale of pay.—The number of posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—The method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications shall be as specified in column 5 of the said schedule.

Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories in accordance with the general orders of the Government of India issued from time to time.

5. Disqualification.—(a) No person, who has more than one wife living, or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life-time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts; and (b) no woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
